GENERAL ENTRY POLICY FOR STUDENTS AT YEARS 10

Melbourne High School admits at least 28 students into Year 10 each year. Applicants should have outstanding current school reports indicating excellent academic attainment and a positive and enquiring attitude to learning. To be eligible for entry, applicants should also have performed at a high level in one or more co-curricular activities, such as music, sport, debating, stage crew and performing arts. Evidence of leadership would also be of benefit. The study of a language, apart from English, is compulsory for all year 10 students. It is advisable that students applying for Year 10 have studied at least one year of one of the following languages: German, French, Japanese or Indonesian.

UNIFORM

Uniform is compulsory and consists of blazer, grey trousers, green pullover, white shirt, School tie, black shoes and black socks. There is a compulsory sport uniform and an optional summer uniform.

ATTENDANCE

School commences at 8.40 am and finishes at 3.25 pm Monday to Friday.

PARENT CONTRIBUTIONS

Parent contributions are in the vicinity of \$1,800.00 annually.

Applicants must mail their Year 10 MHS Application Form (download from MHS website), photocopies of secondary school co-curricular evidence and copies of school reports to arrive at Melbourne High School by Monday 30 May 2022.

Please use an *Express, guaranteed delivery* envelope, which can be purchased from Australia Post outlets.

REGISTRATION FEE

A non-refundable fee of \$120 is payable when you register online to sit the academic abilities assessment.

THE WRITTEN APPLICATION HAS FIVE SECTIONS

1. ACADEMIC RESULTS

A copy of the prospective student's full mid-year and end of year school reports from 2021 must be submitted with this application. Academic grades and teacher comments regarding cooperation, participation, self-management, and ability to meet deadlines will be considered. Students who are shortlisted for interview will be asked to bring their 2022 end of semester 1 report with them to the interview.

2. PERSONAL RESPONSE

The prospective student is asked to write, **in his own handwriting**, his personal reasons for wanting to join Melbourne High School. Applicants may state if they have applied previously.

3. ACHIEVEMENTS

- i. Secondary School Academic Achievements: where applicable, students may include evidence of outstanding academic achievements.
- ii. Secondary School Co-Curricular Achievements: this section requires prospective students to highlight the co-curricular activities undertaken in their current school or local community. This may include statements regarding music, sport, debating, performing arts, leadership and cultural activities. One photocopy per academic and co-curricular achievement should be provided as evidence. Evidence of involvement at state level must be provided.

4. FAMILY ASSOCIATIONS WITH MELBOURNE HIGH SCHOOL

If there is a current or past association with Melbourne High School students can detail this here. This is not a criterion for selection.

5. CONSIDERATION OF DISADVANTAGE

Factors that may require special consideration can be documented. Students' prior educational opportunities, as well as short or long-term disadvantage or hardship will be considered. This could include Interrupted schooling or a personal or family situation which may have impacted extensively on the student's educational opportunities.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

The Registrar and The Principal oversee the following steps:

- ♦ Applications given to the selection panel
- ♦ Selection panel reviews applications and shortlists candidates.
- ♦ Selected candidates are invited to an interview.
- ♦ Student places offered to successful candidates.

TIMELINE

Interviews of short-listed candidates are part of the selection process.

All candidates are notified of the results in late August.

- Where attachments are required, please send photocopies of secondary school achievements ONLY
- We do NOT require a covering letter, photograph of the applicant, or teacher references
- We do require a photocopy of the applicant's 2021 mid-year and end of year school reports
- Applicants MUST sit the Academic Abilities Assessment Test. The non-refundable registration fee of \$120.00 is paid online at the end of the online registration process.

IMPORTANT: Applicants applying to Melbourne High School, as well as Nossal High School, and Suzanne Cory High School:

The Academic Abilities Assessment Test is specific to the four selective entry high schools only: Melbourne High School, Nossal High School, Suzanne Cory High School and The Mac.Robertson Girls' High School. Students must sit this specific test.

- Students applying to more than one selective entry school will sit the entrance test **once** only.
- The online application must be submitted for each school that the student is applying to attend. The first submitted application will be allocated as the sitting school and the student will sit the test at this school. This cannot be changed after the 30 May. Please note that the venue capacity at any one school may mean seating allocations need to be amended.
- Results from the test will be transferred to the selective entry high schools to which the student has applied.
- Students must comply with the individual school's special application conditions, shown on each school's website.

Application Conditions for Melbourne High School:

Students must complete the MHS Application Form in their own handwriting and mail it together with photocopies of school reports and secondary school co-curricular evidence to Melbourne High School.
